## KNOW YOUR SURROUNDS

Oaks Goldsbrough is a heritage listed building that was established in the 1800's as a wool store.

The Goldsbrough was designed as a wool store by William Pritchard and was built by the Stuart Brothers in 1883.

In 1935 the Goldsbrough building caught fire and burned for almost two weeks. The building was later restored by its original builders.

In 1995 the building was converted to 500 apartments with the addition of four floors.

The lanolin-aged hardwood floor, wooden beams and 12 foot ceilings ensure the building retains its unique character.
